Intermiel is one of the largest honey producers in Quebec, with a full line of honey products available for sale. They also produce maple syrup and apple products. Originality and innovation are characteristics that distinguish Intermiel from others. Over the years, several product lines have been introduced, all based on the farm's raw materials. We can discover the various gourmet products, cosmetic products and artisanal beverages that have made Intermiel's reputation.

Date: Tuesday, October 7

Place: 1. Intermiel, 10291 rang de La Fresniere, Mirabel Saint Benoit, Quebec. From Hawkesbury take highway 50 to highway 148 East (outside of Lachute). Go east approx. 12 km, and turn right on to rang Saint Etienne. After ca. 2 km turn left on Montee Rochon. Go 1 km. and turn right on Chemin Fresniere (which becomes 10291 rang de La Fresniere). Follow this west to Intermiel (ca. 3 km).

2. RestoBar Le Caucus, 563 rue Principale, Lachute. (Brent will provide detailed directions on how to get from Intermiel to the restaurant).
