Atlantic Braids was founded in 1976. It is a family owned and operated business (including one of our own members, George Henderson). They offer an extensive selection of premium cordage, including solid braided and diamond braided cordage, twine and rope, made from nylon and polyester, for a wide variety of applications. Atlantic Braids has the largest rope braider in Canada, and can produce rope varying in diameter from 1/32" to 5". A major part of their production is exported to Japan, Australia and the United States.

Place: Atlantic braids is located at 100 Concession Road 1, near the border between Ontario and Quebec. Follow highway 417 east to exit #1 (for Pointe Fortune). Turn right on Montee Janssen (in Quebec), which crosses Grande Montee and becomes Concession Road 1 in Ontario.
