



Permitted Uses of Funds

Here are some examples of permitted uses of funds from the CSC Legacy Fund. These are based on its goals and purpose:

- Public lectures or presentations (including presentation of chemical experiments) by chemical scientists or their students to the general public, community groups or youth organizations;
- Educational sessions held at universities and colleges on subjects of general interest in the chemical sciences that are open to the general public;
- Educational presentations by universities and colleges for the benefit of high school students and in particular those interested in pursuing a career in chemical science;
- Chemical competitions for high school and elementary school students;
- Events or projects that impact upon a large number of Canadians;
- Field trips;
- Scholarships, awards, bursaries, prizes and other honours for attendance at professional conferences or other educational opportunities;
- Scholarships, awards, bursaries, prizes and other honours in support of education at academic institutions;
- Continuing education courses;
- Translation — ensuring high quality educational material in both official languages;
- Travel to conferences or other educational opportunities;
- Mentoring — linking those willing to learn with those willing to share;
- Research, as related to education in chemistry;
- Creation of course modules for students of any age at any academic institution.
