Bao and Zhu Innovation Award

The award shall be presented to a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada who has made a distinguished contribution to the field of chemical engineering while working in Canada. Nominees for this award shall not have reached the age of 40 by January of the year in which the nomination becomes effective.

Deadline

December 1 every year

Sponsor

Award

- A framed certificate
- \$1,000 cash prize

Nomination Requirements

A nomination package must be submitted electronically through [ScholarOne](#). The package should include the following:

- Citation (maximum 250 words) statement of why the candidate should receive the award. This is the key document in the nomination and this information should be relevant to the achievements for which the award is being offered.
- Biographical Sketch (maximum one page) providing background information of the nominee and their accomplishments. This is a summary of information obtained from a Curriculum Vitae.
- Curriculum Vitae (maximum nine pages).
- Proof of age (a copy of valid government document).
- Supporting Letters (3 to 5). At least two letters must be from outside the nominee's organization.

Notes

The award shall be presented at the Canadian Chemical Engineering Conference in which the winner will be required to register and present an award lecture.

The recipient of the award is encouraged to [submit](#) to the Editor-in-Chief of [The Canadian Journal of Chemical Engineering](#) a manuscript based on the award lecture, having contents appropriate to the Journal's objective, for consideration of publication.

Membership in the Society is not a prerequisite for this award.

Nominations that are not awarded will remain active for three years in total, commencing from the initial nomination date. The nominators are responsible for keeping the record of their nominees up to date and complete.

Notes

The award shall be presented annually unless

- the committee considers that no suitable candidate is nominated, or
- less than two nominations are received

When considering a nominee who has applied for multiple awards (or is already an award winner), the committee will evaluate the nominee based on their accomplishments that are different from those being considered (or already recognized in the last five years) by other award committees.
