## Award for Best Graduate Student Paper in *The Canadian Journal of Chemical Engineering*

This award will be given for outstanding published work in *The Canadian Journal of Chemical Engineering* by a graduate student while studying at a Canadian university during a 12-month publication period. This award is presented to the graduate student author(s) of a single paper. The graduate student must be the primary author. Faculty advisors may be co-authors.

### Deadline

December 1 every year

### Sponsor

The Canadian Journal of Chemical Engineering

### Award

- A framed certificate
- One complementary registration for the Canadian Chemical Engineering Conference in which the award will be presented. If there is more than one graduate student authoring the paper, only one registration fee will be provided.
- A short biography of the award winner will be published in [\*The Canadian Journal of Chemical Engineering\*](#) (*Can. J. Chem. Eng.*) to showcase the winner's work. For multiple graduate student authors in the award-winning paper, biographies of each graduate student will be published.

### Notes

The award winner will be required to present the paper in the conference.

Membership in the Society is not a requirement.

No application is required for the award.

### Selection Committee

The Publications Committee is responsible for choosing a winner from a list of candidates prepared by the *Can. J. Chem. Eng.* Editor-in-Chief and Associate Editors. The committee will consider originality and quality of research or design, theoretical soundness, and impact in making its choices.

The committee reserves the right not to award a prize in any given year if they deem that the papers are not of high enough quality.
