## Award in Design and Industrial Practice

This award is presented to a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada for innovative design or production activities accomplished in Canada.

### Deadline

December 1 every year

### Sponsor

### Award

- A framed certificate
- \$1,500 cash
- The award shall be presented at the Canadian Chemical Engineering Conference in which the winner will be required to register and present an award lecture.

### Eligibility

The activities may have resulted in a significant achievement in product or process design, small or large company innovation, or multidisciplinary design-directed research or production. The achievement will relate to the practice of chemical engineering and/or industrial chemistry whether in research and development, process implementation, entrepreneurialism, innovation, production, or some combination of these. It may be via a well-known, long-standing reputation for translating chemical engineering principles into design and industrial practice which contributes to the profession as a whole.

### Notes

The award is open to all chemical engineers and industrial chemists or those practicing these disciplines; it is not restricted to those whose normal employment is in the industrial sphere.

### Nomination Requirements

A nomination package must be submitted electronically through [Awards Force](#). The package should include the following:

- **Citation** (maximum 250 words) statement of why the candidate should receive the award. This is the key document in the nomination and this information should be relevant to the achievements for which the award is being offered.
- **Curriculum Vitae** (maximum nine pages).
- **Supporting Letters** (3 to 5). At least two letters must be from outside the nominee's organization.

### Notes

Membership in the Society is not a prerequisite for this award.

Nominations that are not awarded will remain active for three years in total, commencing from the initial nomination date. For the nomination to be considered during the active duration, the nominators are responsible for resubmitting through Awards Force annually and keeping the record of their nominees up to date.

## Notes

The award shall be presented annually unless the committee considers that no suitable candidate is nominated.

When considering a nominee who has applied for multiple awards (or is already an award winner), the committee will evaluate the nominee based on their accomplishments that are different from those being considered (or already recognized in the last five years) by other award committees.
