

Chemical Institute of Canada - Vice Chair

The Chemical Institute of Canada (CIC) is seeking a chemist or chemical engineer to fulfill the role of Vice Chair on its Board of Directors. This position is a one-year term, after which the Vice Chair will typically become the Chair of the Board for an additional year and the Past Chair for a year. The term begins following confirmation by the Membership at the Annual General Meeting of the CIC (typically in June).

Duties of the Vice Chair include:

- Assist the Chair and assume the duties of the Chair if needed (e.g., the Chair is unable to attend a meeting or event),
- Learn the current issues of the organization, and help develop and/or drive the CIC strategy,
- Help the Chair with oversight of the National Team, including management of the Executive Director and other Human Resources matters, and
- Serve as a Member of the Chemical Education Fund charitable organization.

We are seeking a dynamic person who has previous experience with the CIC and is interested in contributing to the growth of this organization. Candidates should have sufficient time and energy to devote to this position and be a leader for all chemical sciences in Canada. As the CIC is a national organization, French-English bilingual candidates are strongly encouraged.

The position will involve attending six to ten virtual board meetings per year and an inperson meeting at the CIC AGM during the CSC Conference, in addition to the specific responsibilities of the Vice-Chair role.
