Michael Cunningham PhD

Michael Cunningham is a Professor in Chemical Engineering at Queen's University where he holds the Donald and Sarah Munro Research Chair. His research program focusses on the development of novel polymer nanoparticles, CO₂-switchable polymers, and sustainably-sourced polymeric materials including hybrids of synthetic polymers and renewable polymers. He is Chair of the International Polymer Colloids Group and recipient of several national research awards including the NSERC Brockhouse Canada Prize for Interdisciplinary Research in Science and Engineering, Macromolecular Science and Engineering Award, Canadian Green Chemistry and Engineering Award, and the Syncrude Canada Innovation Award, as well as the Queen's University Prize for Excellence in Research and the Professional Engineer's Ontario Research and Development Medal. He is a Fellow of the Chemical Institute of Canada, Canadian Academy of Engineering, Engineering Institute of Canada and Royal Society of Chemistry (UK). He has extensive experience as a CScE Board member, having previously served as a member at large and Director of Awards (2002-2008), and more recently as Vice-President, President and Past President. It was during his term as President that the new concurrent CSC/CScE conference model was initiated.
